Dance Performances

Sitka is home to the renowned “**New Archangel**” Russian Dancers and the “**Naa Kahidi**” Native Dancers. Each of these groups perform traditional and ceremonial dances, to intrigue and entertain your meeting delegates.

The **Southeast Alaska Indian Cultural Center**, located at the **Sitka National Historical Park** visitors center, features authentic carvers, weavers, and other fine crafts people, who still use ancient techniques and methods to produce beautiful and ornate traditional goods.
