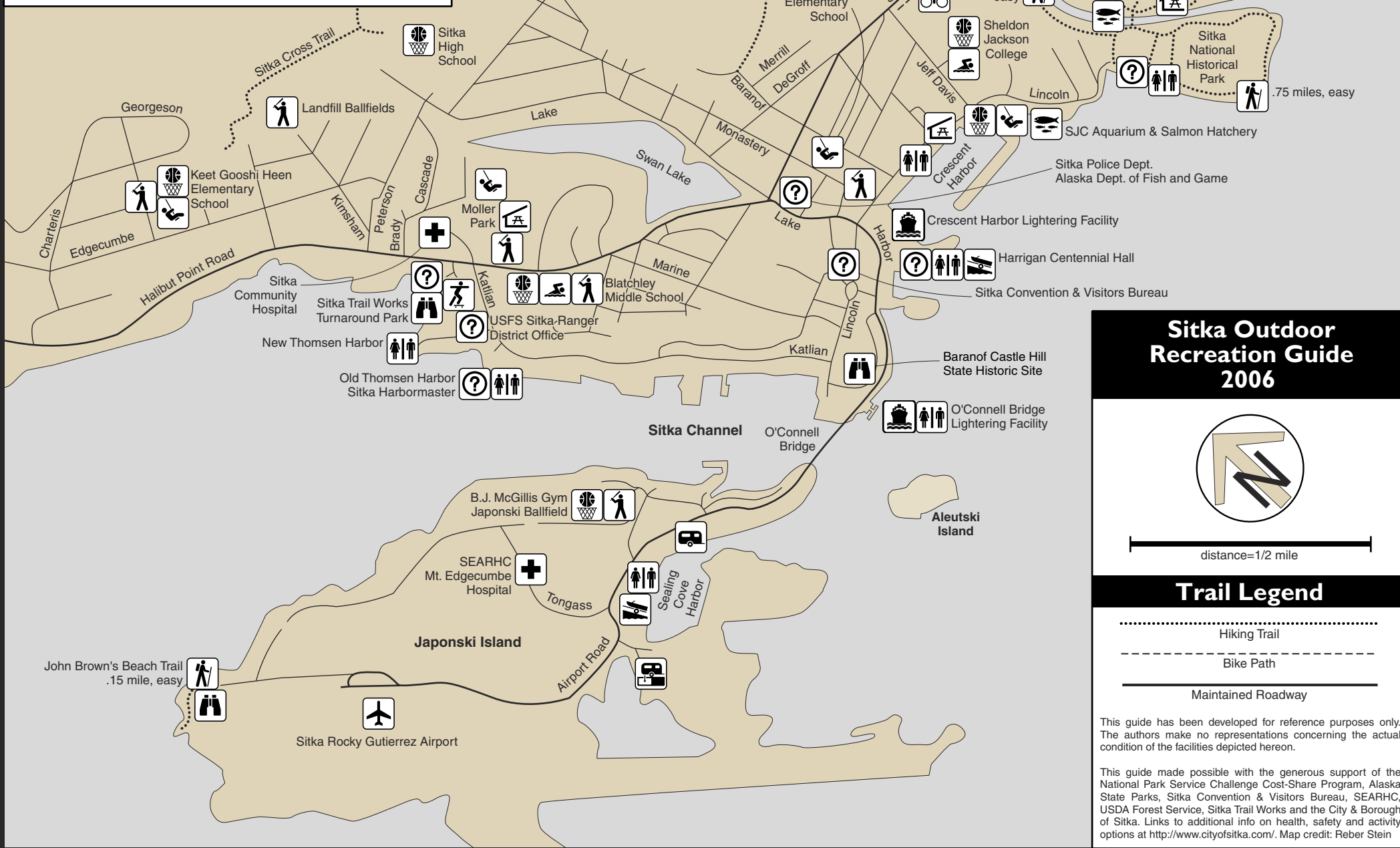

- Be aware that brown bears inhabit the Sitka area. To avoid problems with bears, carry noisemakers or travel in groups.
